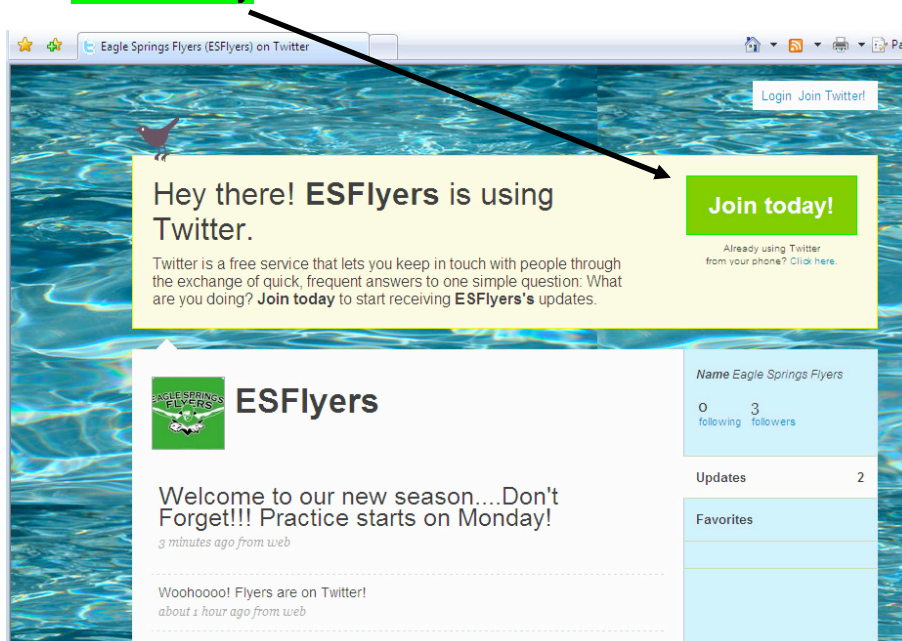
Just imagine up to the minute updates coming from the coaches and board member. Here are just a few examples of the types of updates that could come straight to your phone.


The steps below will help you set up your account.

- 2) Click on **Join Today**



### 3) Complete the Join the Conversation page


- As you complete Full Name and Username you will be looking to receive a **✓ OK** for both items.

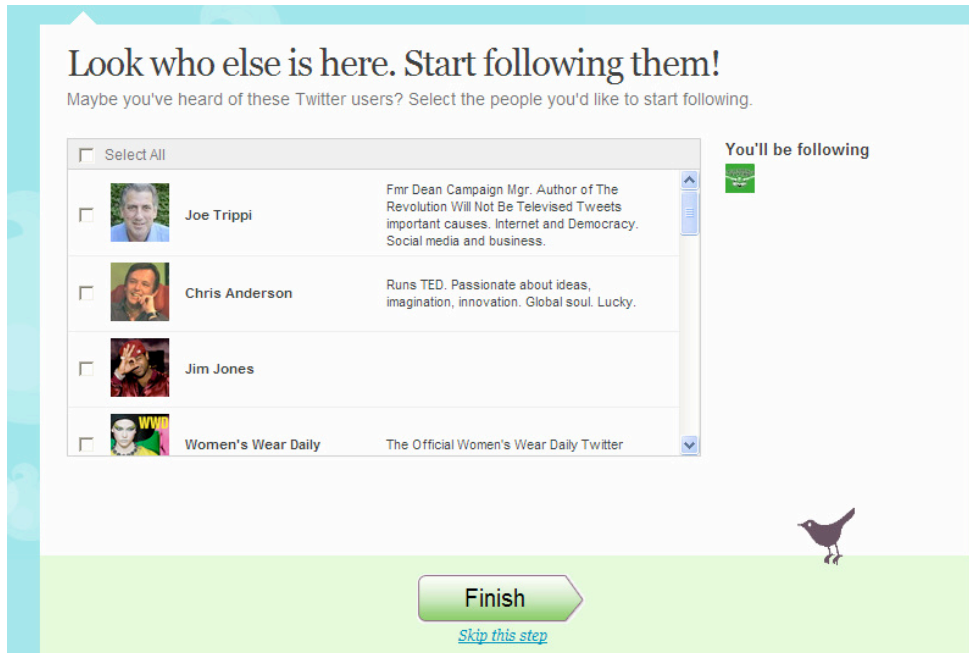
### 5) You can look for friends now or **Skip this step** on the below page



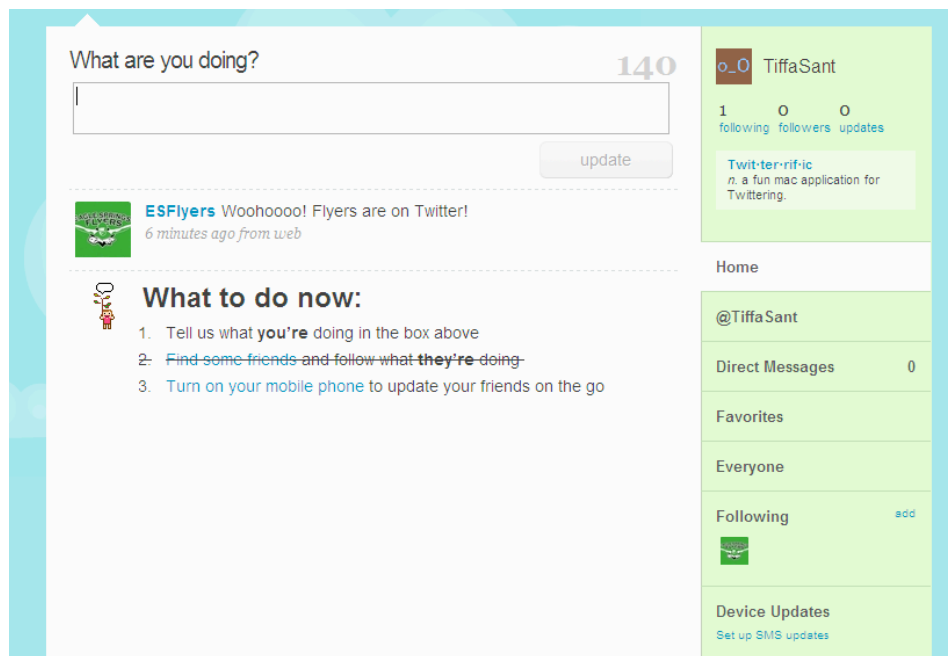





9) Enter you cell phone number and click **Save**

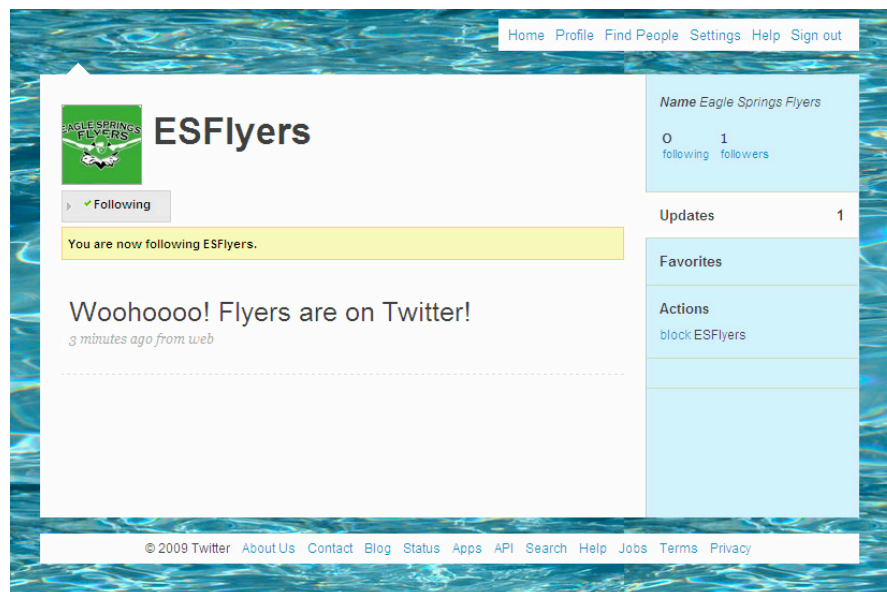
10) You will be given a verification code.

- Text the **Code** to 40404

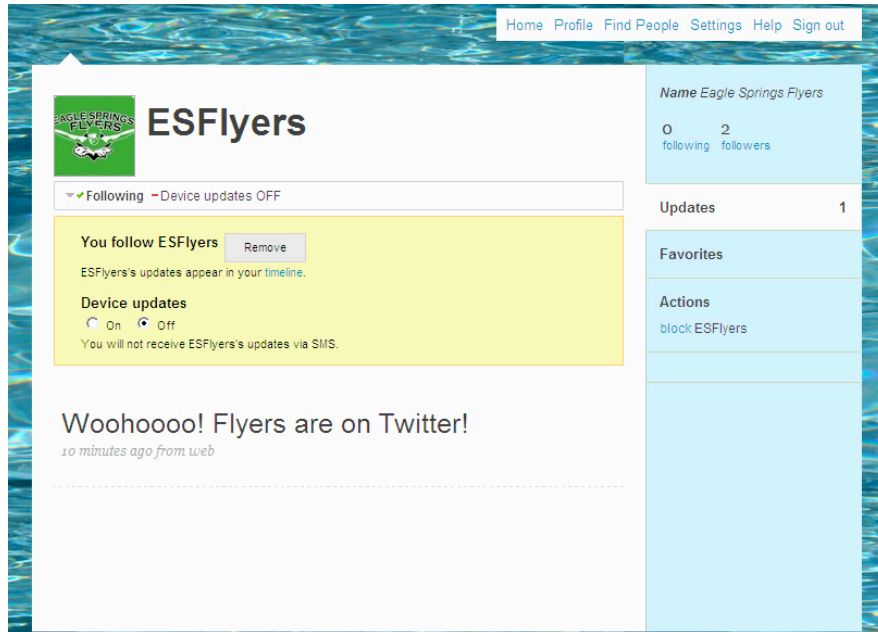


11) Back on your **Home** screen
